8. I will require my team/daughter to uphold Roswell Girls Softball zero tolerance policy of treating players, parents, coaches, umpires, board members and spectators with respect: regardless of race, sex, religion, creed or ability.
9. I will refrain from any and all vulgar, lewd or obscene language or gestures while participating in or watching any league sponsored event whether at home or away.
10. I will direct all my comments and criticisms to parents, coaches, umpires and board members away from the children participating in the league, and conduct myself in a calm, civilized manner when doing so.
